The incarnation of Lord Vishnu would not only ascertain duties and responsibilities and would help and control them properly. Lord Vishnu would create as Brahma, maintain as Vishnu and dissolve as Siva, the universe and all its elements and entities at appropriate times. Please continue to read for more details...]

The Manoos, the Sons of Manoos, the Saptharshees, all Dheva-Genaas and the Indhraas are all appointed by various Incarnations of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan. Therefore, they are all obliged to comply with all commands and orders of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan without any deviation.

Hey, Mahaaraajan! At the end of every Chathur-Yuga or Four Yugaas, the Great Scholarly Rishees who have mastered in Vedhaas and Vedhic knowledge would re-establish the Sanaathana Ddharmma or Eternal Principles of Religion, having seen that the Eternal Occupational Duties of Mankind have been misused and or erased.

[The four steps are Ddharmma (piety, morality and duties), Arthttha (health, wealth and means of life), Kaama (love, relationships and emotions) and Moksha (liberation, freedom and self-realization)]

Manu Puthraas or sons of Manoos are all Rulers or Kings of various countries or states. Manu-Puthraas and their sons and the Dhevaas or Deities who are all recipients of Yaaga Offerings and their associates and subordinates and all of them together maintain Principles of Occupational Duties in accordance with Vedhic norms, in the universe. That means The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan has assigned duties according to their positions and ensures establishment and proper maintenance.

Indhra, the king of heaven, receiving benedictions and potency from The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan, is thus enjoying highly developed opulence, properly maintains the living entities of all the three worlds of the universe by pouring enough rains in all the planets as required at appropriate times.

In every Yuga, Sree Hari Bhagawaan or The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan assumes the Form of Sidhddhaas such as Sanaka to preach transcendental knowledge. He assumes Forms of great saintly Rishees such as Yaajnjavalkya to teach the way of Karmma Yoga and assumes the Form of great Yogees such as Dheththaathreya to teach the system of Mystic Yoga. That is the way The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan establishes Bhakthi, Jnjaana and Karmma Yogaas in the universe in all Manvantharaas.

The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan assumes the Form of Prejaapathi or Prejesa or Brahma and ensures the creation of the Universe and all its entities and elements at appropriate times. He then assumes the Form of Kings and Emperors to destroy thieves, rogues and robbers from time to time. He takes the Form of Time and annihilates everything at an appropriate time. All the different qualities

of material existence should be understood to be the qualities of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Maha Vishnu Bhagawaan.

In One Kalpa or in a day of Brahma many changes take place and they are called Vikalpaas. Learned scholars, who know the Past, Present and Future, have already ascertained that in One Kalpa or within One Day time of Brahma, there are Fourteen Manvantharaas and that many Manoos. Oh, Pareekshith Mahaaraajan! I have already described all these things to you earlier.
