Poorvvardhddhe – KaaliyaMokshanam [KaliyaMardhdhanam] (Chastising and Liberating Kaaliya Serpent [Persecuting and Removing the Ego and Anger of Kaaliya])

[In this chapter we can read the story of Serpent Kaaliya. Kaaliya was living with his family and followers in Kaalindhi or Yemuna. One day when Sree Krishna went with Gopa friends, but without Belaraama, to graze cows in Vrindhaavana, they were resting on the banks of Kaalindhi. Being

very hot and thirsty, the Gopaas and the cows drank water from Kaalindhi and all of them lost their lives due to the contamination of water with deadly poison emitted by the Kaaliya serpent. Sree Krishna revived them all with His Yoga Prebhaava. Having decided to drive away Kaaliya from there and make the river usable to the public, He jumped into the deep whirlpool where Kaaliya used to live with his family. Initially, Kaaliya coiled and enwrapped Krishna tightly so that He could not move. As Gopaas have some bad omen that something untoward is going to happen to Krishna, they also reach the banks of Kaalindhi looking for Krishna and His friends and cows. They all fell unconscious, seeing the terrible sight of Krishna being enwrapped by the snake. Realizing the difficulties and distressful conditions of Gopaas, Krishna subdued and brought Kaaliya under his control. Seeing the distressful condition of Kaaliya, his wives worshipped and offered obeisance to Krishna ceaselessly. [Why Kaaliya moved from Remanaka to Kaalindhi will be explained in the next chapter.] How was it possible for Little Sree Krishna Bhagawaan to drive away that most ferocious and terrifying serpent with deadly poison from Kaalindhi river.

In that Kaalindhi river there was a deep whirlpool in which the Kaaliya Serpent used to live comfortably. The deadly and fiery poison of Kaaliya constantly heated and boiled its waters in that whirlpool. The vapors thus created were so poisonous that the birds that fly over it would burn to death instantly and fall down on it.

Thus, there were no creatures nor any plants, trees nor any vegetation in that whole area.

When That Paramaathma Bhagawaan Who contains the whole Universe within His abdomen jumped into the poisonous whirlpool of Yemuna, with His unbearable weight all the Snakes and Serpents who were the friends, followers and relatives of Kaaliya Sarppa got agitated and started vomiting

As the snake had very tightly bonded Little Sree Krishna Bhagawaan with its coils, when He expanded His body in all dimensions, the snake got squeezed and crushed his body. Due to the squeezing and crushing of his body, the serpent was in terrible pain. Due to unbearable pain the Kaaliya serpent loosened the coil and got away from Kannan or Little Sree Krishna Bhagawaan. Kaaliya became very angry and extremely raged, blossoming and raising his hoods, heavily breathing in and out very often, emitting and spreading deadly poisonous gas through his nostrils, turning his face very reddish, and staring straight with protruded eyes at Little Sree Krishna Bhagawaan.

[Geruda is the enemy and killer of Sarppaas or snakes.] The most terrifying Kaaliya turned around and looked for a chance to bite and inject deadly poison to Kanna or Little Sree Krishna Bhagawaan.
