After getting the Physical Association of the Body of Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan from His embracement, I will stand in front of Him bowing down my head and worshiping Him ceaselessly with folded hands. Oh, My God! At that time, Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan Who is with Most Exalted Fame and Glory will call me: Oh, My Dear Akroora! Oh, My Dear Thaatha, meaning Father, but here Father likes Person or Fatherly Personality! And I instantaneously attain full satisfaction of life and the purpose of my life would be fulfilled at that same moment. Indeed, the life of anyone who is not regardfully recognized by Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan is simply despicable and pitiable."
