Dhevakeedhevi, Rohineedhevi, and Vasudhevar could not see their sons, Krishna or Sreenivaasa Bhagawaan or Mallari Jenaardhdhana Sauri Bhagawaan Dhevakeenandhana Krishna or Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawan and Raama or Anantha Moorththy Sankarshana Belabhadhra Bhagawaan and lost consciousness out of distressful anguish.

Dhevakeedhevi, Rohineedhevi, and Vasudhevar; the parents of Krishna or Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan and Raama or Sankarshana Belabhadhra Bhagawaan; gave up their lives at the very spot where Krishna and Raama left for their abode of Vaikuntta Padham, being tormented by separation from their sons. The wives of Yaadhavaas jumped into the funeral pyre embracing the dead body of their beloved husbands as they were unable to live in pain from the separation of their husbands.

Bhagawaan Maddhusoodhana is Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan and He is Eternally Present in Dhvaaraka. It is the most auspicious of all the places in the universe. Simply by remembering

the name of Dhvaaraka and DhvaarakaaVaasi Bhagawaan Maddhusoodhana all our contamination will be destroyed.

Ddhananjjaya or Paarthttha took all remaining survivors of Yaadhava Dynasty like the women, children, and old men to Indhrapresttha, previously the capital of Paandavaas, and installed Vajra or Vajra Naabha as the ruler of Yaadhavaas. [Vajra was the son of Anirudhddha and grandson of Predhyumna and great grandson of Sree Krishna Bhagawaan.]

Having heard the destruction of their closest relatives and allies, Yaadhavaas – especially of Krishna Who is Bhagawaan Hari or Sreenivaasa Bhagawaan or Mallari Jenaardhdhana Sauri Bhagawaan Dhevakeenandhana Krishna or Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawan – your grandfathers, like Ddharmmaputhra, Bheema, Arjjuna, Nakula, and Sahadheva coronated you as the Ruler and Maintainer of the Kuru Dynasty and left to prepare for their Mahaa Prestthaana or Great and Final Journey or departure from this world.

He is Dheva-Dheva or God of all gods and The Supreme God. He is Vishnu Bhagawaan. Any Marthya or Human Being who proclaims the glorious Incarnations or Births and the play-like activities of those Incarnations like Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan with devotion and concentration would certainly be liberated from all the material contaminations and miseries and attain ultimate Mukthi or Salvation. There is no doubt about it.

Anyone who clearly chants or recites His glorious pastime activities with full concentration and dedicated devotion and offer it as a worship and obeisance unto His Lotus Feet would certainly attain Aathma Samthripthi and Aathmasaakshaathkaaram or Transcendental Realization which is the ultimate aim or goal of a Perfect Sage. Such a person would be a True, Staunch, and Steadfast Devotee of Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan.
