How is it possible for One to worship, pray, and offer obeisance to him by Kriya Maargga or by Performance of oblations, offerings, austerity, and penance? Please be kind and compassionate and explain to us, who are extremely interested and eager to know the details of that method, particularly, of Kriya Maargga. Please also explain to us how His devotees can conceive of His Limbs (think of Viraat Roopa or Cosmic Form,) Associates, Weapons, and Ornaments in terms of particular material representations. We know that by properly and expertly worshipping Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan, The Supreme Soul and The Supreme God, the Mortal can become Immortal. [That knowledge was from the story of Maarkkandeya Maharshi.]

Once One is able to instill this Viraat Roopa in Consciousness, he would be able to visualize or see all the Three Worlds of the Universe and all its entities and elements, both living and non-living and moving and non-moving within that Viraat Roopa or Cosmic Form or Universal Form.

Mrithyu or Death is His Anus; His hands are Dhikpaalakaas or gods protecting all Directions; and Chandhra or Moon is His Mind. Dhiks or Directions are His Ears; the Heavenly Planets are His Head; Yema or god of Death is His Eyebrows; Lejja or Shame is His Lower Lip; Lobha or Greed is His Upper Lip; Smaya or Delusion is His Smile; Jyothsna or Moonshine is His Teeth; while Bhooruha or Trees are His Body Hairs; and Meghaas or Clouds are the Siroroama or Hair on His Head.

The Soorya Mandala or the Globe of Sun is the place where The Supreme Lord Mahaapurusha Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan is worshipped; Dheeksha or Spiritual Initiation is the means for purification of Aathma or Soul [Aathma is always pure and doesn't need any purification but what is meant here is our conditioned soul is corrupted and contaminated with the influence of material modes of nature]; offering prayers and obeisance to The Supreme Lord Mahaapurusha Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan is the process for eradicating all sinful reactions.

And Garuda, who carries Him, or His signatory Vehicle is the Three-Fold Vedha. Yejnja or Sacrifice is His Own embodied Form as all Yejnjaas are offered for Him.

Sree Mahaa Lakshmi, the Goddess of Fortune and Auspiciousness, never leaves Bhagawaan Hari or The Supreme Lord Mahaapurusha Yedhooththama Uththamasloka Vaasudheva Sree Krishna Bhagawaan Who is the Incarnation of The Supreme Soul Lord Sree Vaasudheva Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan's side and always appears with Him in this world as His Internal Potency. Vishvaksena is the chief among the Paarshadhaas or Personal Associates of Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan. He is well-known as the Personification of Panjcha-Raathra Thanthra or Performance of Five Nights Sacrificial Ceremony and other Thanthraas. And Sree Mahaa Vishnu Bhagawaan's Eight Doorkeepers headed by Nandha, and others represent Ashta Aiswaryaas or Eight Opulences or Mystic Perfections beginning with Anima. [Anima, Mahima, etc. are Ashta Aiswaryaas.]
