10. Ruru Dundubha Samvaadham (10. Conversation Between Ruru and The Rat-Snake)

Understanding that the Rat-Snake took that form due to the curse of a great Maharshi, Ruru demanded or requested it to explain the story in detail

Ruru Said:

My wife, who is so dear to me like my own life, had been bitten by a serpent or snake and killed her. From that day onwards I have taken a firm determination and an oath to kill all snakes and to destroy the entire serpent species.

My austere vow was if I see a snake kill it. Therefore, I am going to hurt and kill you now. You do not have any escape and are dead. 2

Dundubham Said:

Hey, Ruro! In the past or previous birth, I was the popular and well-known Muni by the name Sahasrapaathth. Due to the curse of a Braahmana, I became a serpent or Rat-Snake like this. 7

What was the reason for the Vipran or the Braahmanan to curse you out of anger in the past? How long do you have to live as a serpent or reptile like this? 8
