26. Sauparnnam – RaamaneeyakaPrevesam (26. About Suparnnan or Garudan – Entry or Admittance to Ramanakam or Remanakam)

Soothan Said:

As Kadhru adorably worshiped like that, Dhevendhran, whose vehicle is the best of all horses called Uchchaisrevas, filled the whole atmosphere and space of sky with dark clouds.

He, Dhevendhran, commanded the cloud to downpour heavy rain along with huge thunder and flashing lightning and the cloud down-poured rain accordingly. 2

If your command is so let it be like that and thunder started roaring like lion and the heavy cloud spread all over the sky as if it is going to be great deluge. 3

Those wonderful and terribly-roaring clouds that were incessantly poured vast quantities of water. And it looked as if huge waves were playing in the sky like a big festival celebration. 4

Huge thunder roared terribly as if they were propelled and moved by flashing lightning and heavy downpour spreading it throughout. 5

The sky looked as if it lost Sooryan and Chandhran forever or the sky was darker than the darkest with neither Sun nor Moon. And the Naagaas or Serpents became so happy as Indhran provided heavy downpour and removed the heat of the brilliant effulgence of the Sun. 6

The surface of the earth was flooded from the heavy downpour and became very cold. And the cold and clear water even reached Resaathalm or the nether world also. 7

All over the surface of earth was covered with countless waves of water. And along with their mother, Kadhru, all Naagaas or serpents reached Raamaneeyakam or Remanakam. 8
